

Lone Worker	Personal injury, conflict	3	3	9	No lone working permitted when performing hairdressing/cutting or associated tasks – suggested open-door policy, plus an ‘escort’ for safety reasons and to mitigate against safeguarding issues.	3	2	6
Assault / Use of Sharps	Cause injury/death/ stress	3	3	9	No lone working permitted. The use of sharps is extremely limited, preference is given to clippers and similar tools.	3	2	6
Anti-Social Behaviour	Personal injury, conflict	3	3	9	Volunteers are offered guidance in deflecting topics and issues and removing themselves from any potential conflict. Again, limited interaction on one-to-one as no lone working permitted should limit exposure to risk.	3	2	6
